

# Math Independent Learning Plan Guidelines

The following information is to get you started on doing math as an independent learner. Here are the criteria for doing work out of the Holt textbook:

## Math Requirements for Holt textbook Learning Plans

- I do not assign homework, you do that. Your task is to learn the concepts within the chapters and then pass the test on it.
- A good pace is to complete at least one section a day in class and one section a day at home.
- ***You may take a Test when you are ready***
  - Use textbook (Read each section, complete the **Guided Practice** at the end of each section)
  - Use <http://my.hrw.com>; The Lesson Tutorial Videos show you how to do the Examples & The Interactive Practice Test can also help
    - See your Learning Plan for Username & password
  - Use the **Study Guide Review** for each chapter to prepare
  - Take the **Chapter Test** as the end of the chapter as practice
    - Check answers in the **Teacher's Edition** on my desk
- If your **score  $\geq 80\%$**  then 😊 go to the next chapter ...
- If your **score  $< 80\%$**  but close, then you do an **Error Analysis** to increase your score
- If you need to **Retake** the test, you must:
  - Complete practice **Workbook** or **Reteach** or **Review** problems and have me check them
  - Take detailed notes in your note book on each section in the Chapter
- I suggest you use **Friday's Tutoring Session** to help with misunderstandings.
- Five EoC problem sets are required for each Chapter. (unless you have already passed the Math WASL or HSPE)

- If you want additional practice worksheets after you have completed the Guided Practice in each section, just ask and I can make you copies.
